•Policy Analysis and Advocacy: The advocacy will be informed by policy analysis and operational research that will be conducted in implementation areas. CBOs and community groups will also collect evidence that will inform the technical research that has been done and adding value to the policy analysis data. The information collected initially will form baseline and subsequent data collection will inform advocacy agenda.

•Institutional Strengthening: This strategic area will focus on strengthening capacity of partner institutions towards maternal and child health outcome. Areas of institution strengthening will be tailor made to the needs of the institution including Leadership skills and Governance, Monitoring and Evaluation, Financial management and Human resource management. This capacity strengthening will also target HDT's own capacity strengthening where its technical and infrastructural capacity will be addressed.

In maternal and child health HDT has contributed to the following:

- Increased quality and quantity of nurses and midwives in Tanzania;
- Increased visibility of family planning among policy makers particularly parliamentarians;
- Increased resource allocation for family planning at district and national levels; and
- Integration of reproductive and child health in HIV programs.
